I write on behalf of the Tribunal in the above-referenced matter.

The Tribunal notes that, in accordance with Section 11 of Procedural Order No. 1 and the guidelines set forth in the Statement of the NAFTA Free Trade Commission on Non-Disputing Party Participation, sufficient time in the procedural calendar must be allocated for any *amicus curiae* applications and submissions to be made, responded to, and decided upon.

Accordingly, please find enclosed **Procedural Order No. 10** issued by the Tribunal today, which sets out in its Annex I the revised procedural calendar for the bifurcated jurisdictional phase.

To ensure that any *amici curiae* have access to the public version of the Parties' submissions on jurisdiction sufficiently in advance of the deadline for their own applications and submissions, the Parties are invited to confer and propose an alternative timetable under the Confidentiality Order in respect of the publication of the Rejoinder Memorial on Jurisdiction, so that the public version thereof could be made available within two months of its submission (*i.e.* by 26 July 2021). The Parties are requested to revert to the Tribunal with their joint proposed alternative timetable or, in the event of any disagreement, their respective proposed alternative timetables, by **Monday, 26 April 2021**.
