Sir,
I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your despatch No. 204 dated 11th August 1938, forwarding a copy of a letter dated 26th July, 1938, addressed to the Netherlands Minister by the Foreign Office, on the subject of the draft treaty relating to the boundary between Surinam and British Guiana.

A copy of the letter has been forwarded to the Chief British Commissioner of the Boundary Commission.

2. With reference to the last sentence of the letter, Major Papworth has observed that the Inauguration Report for the Northern Territory of the Surinam boundary gives the following geographical Co-ordinates:-

Latitude 05° 59' 53.6" North
Longitude 57° 08' 51.5" West.

The alteration from 53.9" to 53.6" is in manuscript and initialed by both Commissioners.
